14<sup>th</sup> Summer course for young flutists in Tuscany

Due to the Corona pandemic, last year's (our 13<sup>th</sup>) summer course had to be cancelled. Filled with hope, 2021 makes us turn the page, and with unrelenting enthusiasm, we now announce our 14<sup>th</sup> summer course for young flute players. The course is aimed at young professionals, and professional students, but also to amateurs with professional aspirations.

Daily:

- A morning yoga class (Prior to daily flute classes. Not compulsory, but highly recommended) (50')
- Class on breathing and sound production, as well as scales and arpeggios (45')
- Each participant will shall have three individual lessons (40')
- Rien de Reede shall dedicate two classes on performance practice, discussing J.S. Bach's Sonata in E-major and W.A. Mozart's Concerto in G-major. Everybody is invited to play in these classes.

Repertoire and/or orchestral excerpts at choice of the student.

*Required materials/preparation:*

Technique class: Scales according to Taffanel & Gaubert (EJ 4); Arpeggio's according to Reichert no. 2 (to prepare by heart before the course!).

For the group lessons on tone production, please bring: Marcel Moyse: *24 Petites études mélodiques*.

Total cost for the course as active participant € 385,00.

Auditors: € 40,00 per day, or € 150,00 for the full course.

The down payment shall not be refunded if a student cancel their application after May 15<sup>th</sup> 2021. The remaining amount of €235,00 has to be paid on the first day of the course.

The lessons shall start on Monday July 12<sup>th</sup> at 10.00 hrs. in the village of Buonconvento (Si). The end of the lessons will be Saturday July 17<sup>th</sup> at 17.00 hrs. On the free day (July 15<sup>th</sup>) students mostly enjoy a visit to nearby Tuscan villages.

Participants need to organize their own hotel accommodation. Albergo Roma in Buonconvento, fully refurbished recently and close to the train station, is an affordable place for students to stay and eat. Please state that you are participating in the course. Sharing a room doesn't always mean that the price for a night is cheaper. Please ask the hotel owner. There are also other possibilities in the village, e.g. Hotel Ghibellino or private rooms. Hotel Ghibellino offers half (or full) pension with good Tuscan meals served in collaboration with nearby Albergo Roma. Ask for half- (mezza pensione) or full (pensione complete) pension.
